1. What is IBBP and why should companies join?

- The Indonesia Business and Biodiversity Platform (IBBP) is a high-level public-private collaboration initiated by IBCSD. Launched in May 2024 with the support of Ministry of Environment and Forestry (KHLK) and also Bappenas, IBBP is designed to position businesses at the center of Indonesia's biodiversity agenda—advancing policy dialogue, sustainable business practices, and nature-positive investment across industries.
 - By joining IBBP, companies will:
 - Help shape national biodiversity policy (IBSAP) through direct engagement with government
 - Access exclusive training, tools, and networking opportunities with leaders in sustainability
 - Strengthen ESG credentials, manage long-term environmental risks, and align with global frameworks like the GBF
 - Participation in IBBP demonstrates strategic leadership, drives innovation, and positions your business as a front-runner in Indonesia's green economy transition.
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2. Is there a fee to participate in IBBP?

- There is no fee to join IBBP—participation is free of charge. Companies are only responsible for funding their own internal programs, making this a low-risk opportunity to engage in a high-impact, strategic platform on nature and biodiversity.
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3. Does the participation in IBBP requires companies to undertake specific activities to participate?

- Through IBBP, companies can showcase their ongoing nature and biodiversity initiatives while gaining access to cutting-edge insights, tools, and collaboration opportunities. The platform offers a space to exchange best practices with industry peers, strengthen sustainability strategies, and stay ahead of emerging global standards. By participating in IBBP, companies not only demonstrate leadership in environmental stewardship, but also unlock pathways to innovation, risk reduction, and long-term business resilience through nature-positive action.

4. Which companies in which sectors are expected to join the IBBP?

- IBBP welcomes forward-thinking companies ready to lead Indonesia's nature-positive transformation. It's especially relevant for businesses that:
 - Operate in biodiversity-critical sectors such as agriculture, forestry, energy, extractives, tourism, manufacturing, or finance—where nature risk equals business risk
 - Demonstrate strong ESG performance (e.g., PROPER Gold/Green, ESG-driven investors) and are looking to stay ahead of regulatory and market shifts
 - Seek to drive innovation or unlock investment in nature-based and biodiversity-positive business solutions
 - If your company is serious about sustainability, resilience, and long-term value creation—IBBP is your platform to lead, influence, and grow.
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5. What benefits will companies that join receive?

- Companies that become members gain exclusive access to strategic benefits that can drive both sustainability and business value:
 - Direct access to policy dialogue and national advocacy efforts, helping shape the future of biodiversity-related regulation in Indonesia

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Frequently Asked Questions - Bahasa Indonesia

1. Apa itu IBBP dan mengapa perusahaan perlu bergabung?

- [Indonesia Business and Biodiversity Platform \(IBBP\)](#) adalah platform kolaboratif pemerintah-swasta yang di-*launching* oleh IBCSD yang didukung penuh oleh KLHK dan BAPPENAS bulan Mei 2024. Tujuannya adalah memperkuat dialog kebijakan, pelaporan keberlanjutan, dan investasi berbasis keanekaragaman hayati untuk sektor industri.
 - Dengan bergabung ke dalam IBBP, berarti Perusahaan akan:
 - Terlibat langsung dalam penentuan arah kebijakan nasional (IBSAP),
 - Mendapat akses pelatihan dan jaringan,
 - Memperkuat reputasi ESG dan manajemen risiko jangka panjang
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2. Apakah keikutsertaan dalam IBBP ini berbayar?

- Tidak. Keikutsertaan dalam IBBP tidak dipungut biaya, biaya yang dikeluarkan adalah untuk menjalankan program Perusahaan itu sendiri.
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3. Apakah untuk keikutsertaan ini, Perusahaan harus melakukan kegiatan tertentu?

- Kegiatan yg dilakukan adalah program perusahaan terkait nature & biodiversity. Dengan ikut serta dalam IBBP, perusahaan bisa memanfaatkan wadah ini untuk berbagi praktik baik dan memperoleh pengetahuan baru guna meningkatkan inisiatif perusahaan dalam nature & biodiversity.

4. Perusahaan di sektor apakah yang diharapkan dapat bergabung di IBBP?

- Semua perusahaan bisa bergabung ke dalam IBBP, terutama perusahaan yang:
 - Beroperasi di sektor dengan dampak atau ketergantungan tinggi terhadap keanekaragaman hayati (seperti pertanian, kehutanan, ekstraktif, energi, wisata, manufaktur, keuangan),
 - Menunjukkan komitmen ESG nyata (contoh: PROPER Gold/Green, investor ESG),
 - Ingin memobilisasi inovasi atau investasi “biodiversity-positive”.
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5. Apa manfaat yang akan diterima perusahaan yang bergabung?

- Perusahaan yang bergabung akan mendapatkan:
 - Akses ke dialog kebijakan dan advocacy,
 - Pelatihan dan sharing knowledge,
 - Jaringan peer learning dan testimoni bisnis,
 - Dukungan dalam menyusun pelaporan TNFD/ESG,
 - Kesempatan terbuka untuk mengembangkan model bisnis berbasis alam.
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6. Bagaimana perusahaan bisa segera bergabung?

- Langkah praktis:
 - a. Isi “[call-to-action](#)” form terbaru di website BfN/IBBP.
 - b. Mengikuti sesi briefing pertama atau on-boarding session.
 - c. Persiapkan internal setup untuk pelaporan dan partisipasi aktif.

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8. Bagaimana komitmen waktu dan sumber daya yang diperlukan?

- Perusahaan diharapkan:
 - Menghadiri minimal dua kegiatan awal (on-boarding + workshop),
 - Mengalokasikan personel untuk diskusi teknis & pengisian form,
 - Menyediakan data/reporting terkait aktivitas keanekaragaman hayati dalam rangka pelaporan TNFD/ESG.
 - Ikut serta dalam kegiatan-kegiatan IBBP
